He answered concerns of truancy (phone 441-5610 or 911 to report), local panhandlers and security at area stores. He also suggested holiday safety tips.

Norfolk Public Library Sergeant Memorial Historical Room archivist and historian, Robert Hitchings, presented with energy and enthusiasm, a program on The Baroness of Norfolk (1826-1907), Mary Ludlow Selden. He has recently left NPL after 14 years and is now with Chesapeake Public Library Wallace Memorial History Room.

President Jim stated that our Holiday Decorating Event, with 3 categories, was to be judged by 3 volunteers beginning Sunday, December 21. Winners would be announced in January. Board member, Scott Guirlinger, proposed a civic league social event at Guads Restaurant in January.
