

PROVIDING TAX RELIEF

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, Norfolk City Council has approved the following tax payment extensions.

MEAL TAXES, ADMISSIONS TAXES, OCCUPANCY TAXES & TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAXES



- If due in April, May or June 2020 – City Treasurer will NOT assess late fee penalty and interest for 60 days.
- Continue to file these taxes as you normally would, even if payment is not possible for 60 days.

BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY, PERSONAL PROPERTY & REAL ESTATE TAXES



- These bills are due June 5, but taxpayers have until August 1 to pay in full without accruing penalty and interest.
- Taxpayers have the option make partial payments by mailing a check to the address on the bill.

ONLINE CONVENIENCE FEES WAIVED UNTIL JUNE 30



- A taxpayer can make payments online without an additional charge for credit cards or e-check payments.
