Membership Meeting Minutes November 15, 2021

(Virtual meeting recording posted on website)

The meeting was opened by President Scott Guirlinger.

Office Toth provided an update on criminal activity in the Wards Corner area.

Darrell Crittendon, Director, Parks and Recreation provided information and answered questions.

- \$4M for planning and design of NFWC
- Library new component for NFWC.
- Community engagement process for NFWC to begin in January.
- Parks and Recreation department in rebuilding mode.
- Facing staffing issues since COVID.
- Offering modified hours at open recreation centers.
- Offering modified athletics, programming, activities, and services.
- Free life saving training for Norfolk residents.
- Plan to reinstate Summer camps and the Norfolk Emerging Leaders Project.
- Darrell to have Parks and Recreation team check out North Shore playground equipment for needed repairs.

Vice Mayor Martin Thomas added city updates and answered questions.

- \$4M budgeted this year for NFWC.
- City Manager and Council to begin process to budget funding for building NFWC next year.
- Something will happen at the old Kroger location.
- Old Farm Fresh property owners very happy to collect rent from Kroger and no changes expected.
- Harris Teeter gas station will take place, not an immediate priority with Harris Teeter.
- Discussed road construction completions.
- Discussed Metro Net construction.

School Board Representative Adale Martin (Ward 1) added school updates and answered questions.

 All staff required to be vaccinated by January 3, 2022 or submit to weekly COVID testing.

- NPS will be providing vaccination clinics for 5-11-year-old students with signed permission slips. Parents need not attend.
- Due to staffing issues and extra work load the board decided to make several schedule changes for holidays, early release days and full teacher unencumbered days.
- NPS will host a public budget meeting for 2023 fiscal year on December 15, 2022.

Halloween decorating contest winners. 1st place 532 Timothy and 2nd place 7458 Millbrook. WCCL will not meet Dec. 20th, will be judging holiday light contest.

The next WCCL meeting is on Monday, January 24 2022.
