For those who may have missed all of the hubbub the last couple of years, Virginia went through an extensive redistricting process drawn up by a commission. The final maps were validated by the courts last year and go into effect with the upcoming election cycle.

The impact to our Wards Corner neighborhood was significant. For the first time in at least two decades, we will vote for and be represented by the same state delegate.

We no longer have to stare at a confusing political map with strangely drawn boundaries to understand who represents whom in our neighborhood. We are all part of the reformed 93rd house district and 21st senate district.

Our current representatives do not live within the boundaries of our new districts, so we will be voting for new representation this spring in the primaries and this fall in the general election. In preparation for this, we plan to host candidates running for office over the course of our meetings between now and November. I hope you can join us or watch online afterward to learn more about the candidates who are vying to represent us starting next year.


Vice President Erin Ward presented ideas for Civic League Community development and provided committee sign up sheets and discussed the new Wards Corner Civic League Facebook page.

The field and surrounding grounds at the Norfolk Fitness & Wellness Center bordering North Shore Ave to the north, and Newport Ave to the west.


This piece of real estate is the largest green space we share as residents within the boundaries of our civic league region. We feel a responsibility to keep these grounds litter-free.


