

SEPTEMBER 18, 2023 MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was opened by 2nd Vice President Chris DePalma.

Officer Steven Toth, Community Resource Officer NPD, provided an update on criminal activity in the Wards Corner area and answered questions.

- · Violent crime is down in Wards Corner.
- · Stolen auto arrests are up in Norfolk.
- · Auto theft down in Norfolk, but up in Wards Corner.
- Provided a crime map of Wards Corner.

Jackie Glass, Candidate, State House District 93 presented her platform and answered questions.

Adale Martin, School Board Representative, Ward 1 provided updates and answered questions.

- New weapon protection system in place this year.
 - Better technology.
 - Mobile devices to be used at every school entrance and sporting events.
- The evaluation process for Superintendent is in process.
- Accreditation status.
 - 25 schools accredited.
 - 16 schools accredited with conditions.
 - Coleman Place School was off the accreditation list and now is on the accreditation list.
 - Ruffner Middle School was performing poorly, and part of a new program called Compass Academy, early focus on career pathways focusing skills and interest with resources.
- Increase in non-speaking English students, primarily Spanish.
- In need of teachers and bus drivers.

Vice Mayor Martin Thomas provided city updates and answered questions.

- 911 call center understaffed.
- Applicant for Kroger building has asked for continuance for rezoning with city council.
- · Farm Fresh building lease up shortly.
- Midtown Shopping Center on market, price drop.
- Provided an update on flood wall.
 - Army Corps of Engineers will be designing the flood wall in phases.
- City owns two malls.
 - Shifting focus to downtown MacArthur Mall as a quicker turnaround.
 - VA Hospital may have interest in Military Circle Mall.
- Developer for Casino changing plans and backing out of original plans.

John Sitka, Candidate, State House District 93 presented his platform and answered questions.

Vice President, Erin Ward provided Civic League Community Development Committee sign-up sheets, discussed the Fall Festival and requested suggestions for future activities.
