We also learned that the DePaul hospital redevelopment will not be moving forward and the property is once again on the market. (The rezoning that was presented to us did go through and is still in effect as it was presented.)

- Dominion is scheduled to be upgrade street lighting along Granby St to new LED fixtures and bulbs next spring or summer.
- The city has approved the placement of a speed enforcement camera at Granby High School for installation next year.





WATCH THOSE TURKEY FRYERS

Planning on frying a turkey this year? Keep these tips from Norfolk Fire-Rescue in mind this holiday season:

- Always make sure the turkey has defrosted.
- Keep fryers outside and away from flammable items.
- Make sure fryers are on a flat, stable surface.
- Don't overfill the fryer!
- Turn off the gas before putting the turkey in.
- Never leave the fryer unattended.
- Keep children and pets away from the fryer.
- Never use water to extinguish a grease fire.
- Keep a fire extinguisher nearby.

KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE!

Thanksgiving is all about food and family and it may be tempting to include our furry family members in the holiday feast, but some of the festive fixings can be harmful to pets.

- Turkey: A tiny bit of meat is ok but never give pets any leftover bones.
- Garlic, onion, leeks and chives: These can be toxic to dogs and cats so it's best to avoid anything cooked with those ingredients.
- Desserts: Chocolate, raisins, currants and the popular sugar substitute Xylitol are toxic for dogs and cats.
- Trash: Secure trash cans so pets aren't tempted to go after the scraps.

MEETING MINUTES

The meeting was opened by President Scott Gurlinger.

Officer Steven Toth, Community Resource Officer NPD, provided an update on criminal activity in the Wards Corner area and answered questions.

Trina Haynes, Public Relations Specialist, Domenic Marino, Senior Project Manager, Allan Myers Hampton Roads Express Lanes Project provided information and answered questions about the I-64 Hampton Roads Express Lanes Norfolk Segment 1A Project.

Project Description

The HREL Norfolk Segment 1A will repurpose I-64 in both directions from Tidewater Drive to Patrol Road in Norfolk. The three existing general-purpose lanes and shoulders will be converted to one part-time, high-occupancy express shoulder lane and three general purpose lanes for a total of two miles.

- Construction Starts: September 2023
- Estimated Completion Date: Early 2026
- Design-Build Contract: \$197.6 Million

- Major Work Includes.

Two miles of shoulder rehabilitation/strengthening on I-64 east and west.

- Roadway widening in some locations to maintain shoulder width.
- Right of way acquisition in some locations.
- Five bridge widening/rehabilitations.
- Three bridge rehabilitations.
- Tolling gantries and overhead signage.

Noise barriers.

Local roads to remain open with traffic barriers.

- · Short term detours.
- Little Creek Road from Tidewater Drive no left turn to 264.
- 564 to Little Creek Road no left turn.
- Tidewater Drive 64 east bound loop ramp.
- No new exit ramps to be added for high-occupancy lanes.

Vice Mayor Martin Thomas provided city updates and answered questions.

- NFWC update: narrowed down to three design and builders for the project.
- City plan to consolidate the many rec centers to five consolidated recreation and library centers that should help with staffing issues.
- Interest rates affecting future building projects, not affecting current projects.
- Sea Wall project proceeding.
- Median fence at Wards Corner being replaced by construction company that mistakenly removed.

Vice President, Erin Ward provided Civic League Community Development Committee signup sheets, discussed the Fall Festival, and requested suggestions for future activities.
