## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Happy Valentine's Day! (A belated one.) This is typically where I write each year about the love that I see around our neighborhood from all of our caring neighbors and city staff. And I do still want to thank you all for sharing the love! But there are also some pressing matters that I need to reserve this space for...

Demolition time has nearly come! By the end of this month, scheduled programs at the Norfolk Fitness & Wellness Center (NFWC) will conclude. And I am told that building access will stop a few weeks later, around mid-March. As of my writing of this message, it is not yet clear if we will be able to host our March meeting in the NFWC conference room or not. Our board is working to secure a nearby meeting space for the next two years while NFWC reconstruction is taking place.

The board has also discussed shifting to meetings every other month, at least during this reconstruction phase. And doing social events in the alternate months. This model has worked well for some other civic leagues and we believe it's worth giving a try. We believe it will help reach some more neighbors and be more inclusive overall. We are working now to plan the rest of our calendar year with meetings and social events. Stay tuned for more information coming very soon!

Also, after tabling the vote on bylaw changes at our January meeting, the board has discussed the concerns and decided to make a motion to adopt the proposed changes as previously presented (no new changes). To recap the proposed changes again, they will give the board the authority to offer a lifetime dues payment in addition to or in lieu of annual dues payments, and set term limits on officer positions (no one person can serve in the same position for more than 3 consecutive years). I hope you all can join us for this important vote. If you have any questions ahead of time, please feel free to reach out to any board member. (A reminder that per official rules, you need to be a registered member of the civic league to vote.)

The groundhog said that winter will be longer this year and it appears he may have been correct. Stay warm and I'll see you out around the neighborhood soon!

### Meeting Minutes, January 27, 2025

The meeting was opened by President Scott Guirlinger.

Office Toth, Community Resource Officer NPD, provided an update on criminal activity in the Wards Corner area and answered questions. Martin Thomas, Vice Mayor, City of Norfolk presented updates and answered questions.

- Former Rite-Aid property owner in process of deciding what to do with the property.
- Next Steps for Success Is conducting a study for the property next to Granby Street for the possible construction of townhomes and carriage houses.
- Norfolk Fitness and Wellness Center, April 2027 scheduled completion date.
- The former Kroger building has no confirmed tenant.
- The former Farm Fresh building, no decisions on use of property.

C.W. Gaskill, Jr., Civil Engineer III, Stormwater Management Division provided updates on the North Shore playground and answered questions.

- All in house design and contracting on the project.
- Landscaping replaced trees and grass.
- Project is complete.

L. Keith B. Darrow, P.E., City Transportation Engineer, presented projects and answered questions.

- New traffic patterns at Terminal Blvd. and Diven.
- \$5 million project to replace streetlights with high pressure sodium to LED.
- Conducting pilot programs for less intrusion of light.
- Federal grant to improve safety at the corner of Hampton Blvd. and Little Creek Rd. Finances will be available next year.
- Bike lanes construction scheduled to begin Spring of 2025. 10–12-month completion.
- Buffer Lanes- curb stops and flex posts to be installed.
- The speed limit on Granby Street will be reduced to 30 mph
- RRFV lights will be installed at 5 locations along Granby Street.

Proposed bylaw changes tabled until February 24, 2025, membership meeting.

## **Bylaw Updates**

From Article VII - Finance: The annual dues and <u>any lifetime dues</u> of the league shall be set by the Board of Directors and shall be per household, payable to the Wards Corner Civic League.

From Article IX - Elections and Voting:It shall be the duty of the Nominating Committee to recommend candidates at the <u>January</u> December meeting, a slate consisting of at least one nominee for each elective office. Nomination may be made from the floor at this time. The election of officers shall take place at the <u>January</u> December meeting. The installation of officers shall take place <u>no later than the February</u> at the <u>January</u> meeting. Officers shall be eligible to succeed themselves <u>for a maximum of three terms</u> in the same office.
